Members with Progressive Organization Support: 13 (all Democrats)

Members with Conservative Organization Support: 4 (all Republicans)

KEY ENDORSEMENT PATTERNS

LABOR UNIONS (WEA, SEIU)

- **Democrats:** 13 of 13 (100%)
- **Republicans:** 0 of 6 (0%)
- **Clear pattern:** All Democrats receive union support, no Republicans do

BUSINESS GROUPS (AWB, Chambers)

- **Democrats:** 1 of 13 (8%) - only Rep. Callan
- **Republicans:** 5 of 6 (83%)

- **Clear pattern:** Republicans receive business support, Democrats don't (except Callan)

PROGRESSIVE ORGANIZATIONS (Planned Parenthood, Environmental)

- **Democrats:** 13 of 13 (100%)
- **Republicans:** 0 of 6 (0%)
- **Clear pattern:** Perfect partisan split

CROSSOVER APPEAL

- **Only 1 member** receives both labor AND business endorsements: Rep. Lisa Callan (D-5)
- Suggests moderate, pragmatic positioning

NOTABLE MEMBERS

Rep. Lisa Callan (D-5) - The Crossover

Gets BOTH: - Labor union endorsements (WEA, SEIU) - Business endorsements (AWB, Chambers) - Progressive group endorsements - Rare crossover appeal

Rep. Shaun Scott (D-43) - The Socialist

Gets standard Democratic endorsements PLUS: - Democratic Socialists of America (DSA) - Socialist Alternative (sometimes) - Some mainstream groups cautious due to extreme positions

Rep. Matt Marshall (R-2) - The Militia Founder

Gets standard Republican endorsements PLUS: - Three Percenters militia community support (not formal endorsement) - Some mainstream conservatives potentially cautious

IMPLICATIONS FOR VOTERS

Labor Endorsements Suggest: - Support for teacher pay increases - Opposition to some charter schools - Collective bargaining rights support

Business Endorsements Suggest: - Fiscal restraint - School choice support - Accountability measures

Progressive Endorsements Suggest: - Equity and inclusion focus - Comprehensive sex education - Restorative justice approaches

Conservative Endorsements Suggest: - Parental rights emphasis - Traditional curriculum -

Local control

END OF ENDORSEMENTS CHART

Summary: Clear partisan divide. Democrats receive labor/progressive support (100%), Republicans receive business/conservative support (83%). Only one member (Callan) has crossover appeal. Two members (Scott, Marshall) receive extreme organization support beyond mainstream coalitions.
